

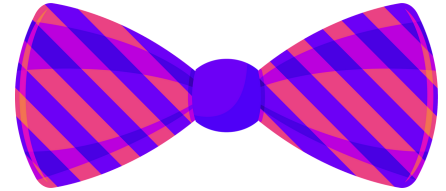

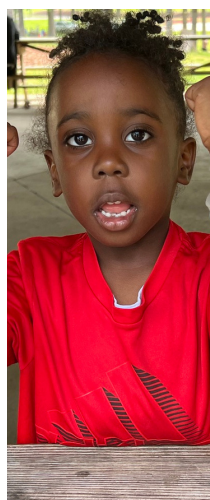

It was called Decoration Day because family and friends of the fallen soldiers would come together and decorate the graves of these brave men with flowers and wreaths.

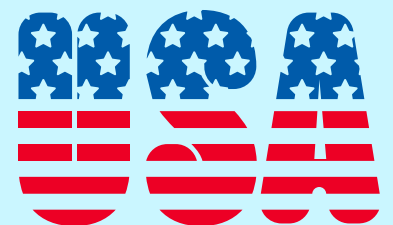
