### True Greatness

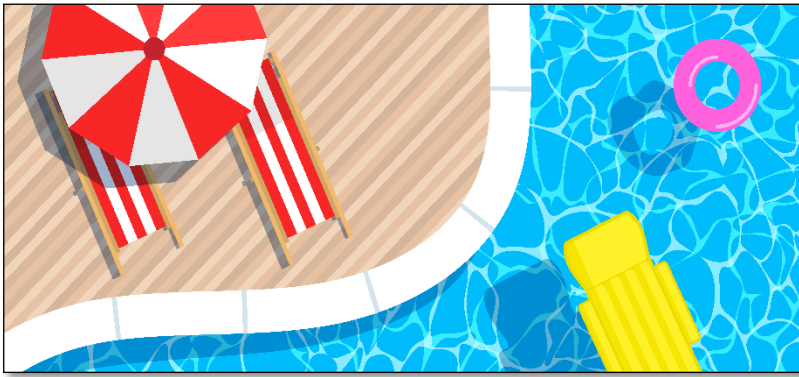


## BISCOE CEMETERY

### Guidelines for Grave Plots

#### Applies to All Sections of the Cemetery

**NO OBSTRUCTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED THAT WILL PREVENT  
ACCESS OF MAINTENANCE OR UPKEEP OF GROUNDS**

- **Head Stones:** Flowers and vases must be attached to headstones.
- **Foot Markers:** Foot markers must be flush to the ground.
- **Flat markers:** at ground level are allowed. **Burial vaults** are required.
- **Benches** are only allowed if it is a head stone on its own lot.
- No **fence** shall be placed or erected in or around said lots.

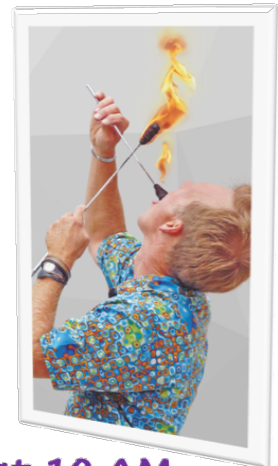

  - Limbs must be no longer than 6 ft. and left curbside.



- Not Allowed**
- Microwaves
  - TVs
  - Computers
  - No Building Materials
  - Lot Clearing/Trees Removal by Homeowner or Contractor
