Biscoe Town Board of Commissioners held a Strategic Planning Retreat in the Spring of this 2022. During this retreat the Board set four priorities and developed specific objectives for each priority. The first priority was to hire a recreation/event director. We are excited to announce the Town of Biscoe has hired Delana Hinson Cagle as our Recreation/Event Director.

As a native of Montgomery County, Cagle graduated from East Montgomery High School in 2012. She then went on to pursue her Criminal Justice degree from Appalachian State University. 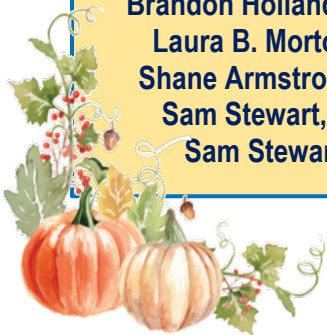

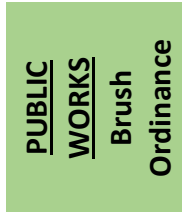
