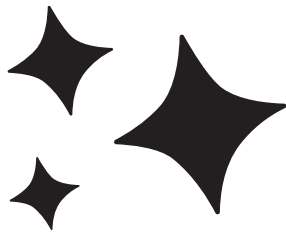

Town Auditors presented their report on Fiscal Year 2021-2023. The Town is in good financial standing and was able to increase fund balance.

## STATE GRANT RECEIVED

The Town of Biscoe received a \$50,000 Parks & Recreation Grant from the State of North Carolina that is being used to upgrade bathrooms at the park, add batting cages at the ballfields, and repair the press box at the Little League Field.

## Town Board Approves Biscoe Park Master Plan & PART-F Grant Application

The Biscoe Town Board of Commissioner held a meeting on April 17, 2023. At this meeting, the Board voted unanimously to approve the proposed Biscoe Park Master Plan and PART-F Application. The PART-F Grant request is for \$500,000 and requires a match of \$500,000. In addition the Town will be applying for a Land & Water Conservation Fund federal grant.

There are many upgrades to the Park that are included in Phase 1 including permanent corn hole boards, shelter/restroom/equipment, relocation of Veterans' Memorial, and a splash pad.

- Limbs must be no longer than 6 ft. and left curbside.

## NOT ALLOWED

- Microwaves
- TVs
- Computers
- No Building Materials
- Lot Clearing/Trees Removal by Homeowner or Contractor
