**HAPPY 100TH BIRTHDAY TO MRS. DOROTHY STEVENS!!!**

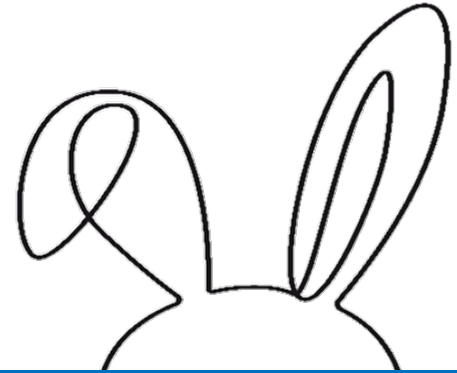

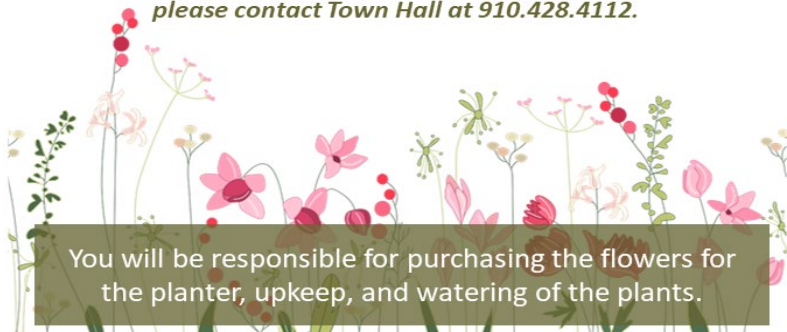

## PLANNING BOARD VACANCIES

Applications are now being accepted for individuals to serve on the Biscoe Planning Board. The Board currently has 2 vacancies (one inside Biscoe City Limits (appointed by Town Board) and one in the ETJ Limits (Appointed by Montgomery County Board of Commissioners). The purpose of the Planning Board is to conduct studies and recommend plans, policies, and ordinances relating to the growth and development of the Town; makes recommendations concerning proposed major subdivisions and proposed land use ordinance and zoning map amendments. They are strictly an advisory board to the commissioners regarding the zoning elements of the Town. Normally, the board will meet once a month on Monday evenings. Applications will be taken through *May 9, 2022*.

The Town of Biscoe is actively recruiting part-time workers for our Swimming Pool. The days run from May to September.

**Lifeguards** must be avid swimmers and Red Cross certified in lifeguarding or willing to obtain Red Cross Lifeguard Certification with the acceptance of this position (Certification Class paid by the employer).

**Concession workers** must work well with the public and be responsible for processing cash, point-of-sale system in a retail environment.
