Mayor Pro tem Smith said if it is not allowed in the current Zoning Ordinance we need to enforce the zoning ordinance.

Commissioner Beard asked how much of the property will be used for the outdoor flea market. Manager Holland the applicant wants to fence in and use the entire piece of property for an outdoor flea market. Commissioner Beard said he was concerned about parking issues.

Manager Holland said no decision has to be made tonight; but they are entitled to a Public Hearing because they went through the application process.
