The NC Department of Environmental Qualities Division of Water Infrastructure will be awarding \$789,400,000 in grant and loan funding to help pay for water and wastewater projects statewide. The Town of Biscoe has been approved for a \$50,000 Asset Inventory Assessment (AIA) Sewer Grant to help prepare the Town Utilities for future growth.
