SCHOOL BREAKS GROUND ON NEW FACILITY

Tillery Charter Academy in Biscoe, NC held a groundbreaking ceremony at their new location on January 12, 2023. The new campus, on 34 acres, is set to open for the 2023-2024 school year in August. Tillery Charter Academy is a public charter school and will offer grades K-6th, eventually expanding and adding a grade level each year.

Teachers, students, parents, TCA Board members, and community members attended the ceremony at 170 Academy Street. Chrissy Fisher, Board Chair and Teresa Harrison, Principal, led the groundbreaking, highlighting the project and the journey that has led to this point.

The new facility will include a 30,000 square foot learning community fully equipped with a fire alarm system, intercom, and secured access on the 34 acre site; 20 spacious classrooms and 2 larger classrooms for Art, Music, and a Science lab, an average classroom space of 700 square feet, a 3,000 square foot multi-purpose room with adjacent concessions, teachers workroom and conference room, 65 parking spaces, to include 6 ADA spaces, and an extended parent drop-off and pick-up loop, separate from the bus lane.

These features will allow our students, faculty, and staff to continue to work to their fullest potential throughout the school day and year. The culture that we continue to strive for will be evident in the classrooms, the hallways, and all areas of Tillery Charter Academy. Courage, respect, and spirit of adventure—our 3 core values will surround this curriculum and our approach each and every day.

§91.02 ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE OR IMPROPERLY CONTROLLED.

Any domestic animal which is found running at large or staked, hitched, or fastened in violation of the provisions of this chapter shall be seized and impounded by the Chief of Police or any person finding the same. The impounder may demand the payment of fees to cover any costs of seizure and impoundment.

DOGS

§91.15 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

At Large. Off the premises of the owner, and not under control either by leash, cord, chain, or otherwise.

Dog. Includes both male and female dogs.

Owner. Any person keeping or harboring a dog, and, for the purpose hereof, the head of a household shall be deemed to be the owner in respect to any dog or dogs owned, kept, or harbored by any person residing in the household and kept on the premises.

§91.16 RUNNING AT LARGE

It shall be unlawful for any person, being an owner of a dog as defined in §91.15, to permit the dog to run at large within the town at any time.



§91.02 ANIMALES CORRIENDO LIBREMENTE O CONTROLADOS INADECUADAMENTE.

Cualquier animal doméstico que se encuentre corriendo suelto o estacado, enganchado o atado en violacion de las disposiciones de este capítulo será capturado y confiscado por el jefe de policía o cualquier persona que lo encuentre. El incautador puede exigir el pago de tarifas para cubrir los costos de incautación y embargo.

PERROS

§91.15 DEFINICIONES.

El propósito de este capítulo, se aplicarán las siguientes definiciones a menos que el contexto claramente indica o requiere un significado diferente.

LIBREMENTE. Fuera de propiedad de uno, y no bajo control ya sea por correa, cordón, cadena o de otro modo.

PERRO. Incluye perros machos y hembras.

PROPIETARIO. Cualquier persona que tenga o albergue un perro el dueño del hogar es responsable a cualquier perro o perros que posean, mantengan o alberguen cualquier persona que resida en el hogar y se mantenga en las instalaciones.
